DiskShredder ToGo Usage Guide

Step-1. Operation Check

Download the DiskShredder ToGo program

Create a bootable DVD of DiskShreder ToGo

Insert the bootable DVD into the PC and turn on the power

After DiskShredder ToGo starts, press [Cancel] on the License Key entry screen

Confirm the list of disks to be erased

If necessary, check the following

- Erasure Time Estimate
- Viewing disk contents
- Saving a operation check log to a USB device

Step-2. Purchase License

Purchase a 90-day usage license from the Personal Media online store

Confirm the 20-digit license key, which will be emailed to you within 5 business days

Step-3. Data Erasure (Can be performed as many times as you like within 90 days from the purchase of the License Key)

Insert the bootable DVD into the PC again and turn on the power

After DiskShredder ToGo starts, enter the license key on the License Key entry screen

Check the list of disks to be erased and specify the erasure method

DiskShredder ToGo performs data erasure

- Overwrite Erase Method for HDD, SSD, eMMC
- Secure Erase Method for HDD, SSD, eMMC
- Sanitize Erase Method for HDD, SSD

Step-4. After the erasure (if necessary)

Check the following

- Saving a erasure certificate to a USB device
- Saving a data erasure log to a USB device
- Viewing disk contents

If DiskShredder ToGo does not start, please check the following

- Immediately after turning on the computer, press the F12 or F9 key or any other key to display a menu for selecting the startup device. Select DVD from the menu.
- Or, on the computer's BIOS screen, change the boot order of the DVD drive to higher than the internal drive.
